He co-chaired the 2000 and 2003 ADEC Conferences and the 2011 International Conference on Grief and Bereavement. He is the co-author of *Grief and Bereavement in Contemporary Society: Bridging Research and Practice* and *Sibling Loss Across the Lifespan: Research, Practice and Personal Stories* (Routledge). He also co-authored both the first and second editions of *Principles and Practices of Grief Counseling* (Springer).
