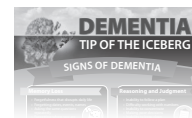
## OBJECTIVES

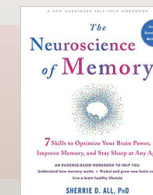

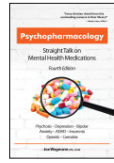
